Last night, Senator Ben Sasse (R-NE) called on the Senate to fast-track a bill to protect babies who *survive* an abortion. Sasse asked that the bill be passed by unanimous consent, meaning it would be immediately approved unless any Senator objected.

IMPORTANT: The bill did not touch the so-called "right" to abortion. We're talking about a baby born alive, gasping for air on the table, having somehow survived the murderous intentions of the abortionist. In every other circumstance, doctors must provide care for this vulnerable child. But because the baby is the result of a failed abortion... the innocent child is considered worthless.

Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell has voiced his support for bringing the bill directly to the Senate floor to force a vote, rather than sending it to committee.
